

## K. Line Poodles K9 Partners Contract

For the purpose of promoting a healthy and diverse bloodline, we (K. Line Poodles) agree to work in conjunction with \_\_\_\_\_ by breeding their rightfully owned female poodle or doodle to a male of our choosing, whelping, raising and marketing the litter.

### **Guidelines**

In compensation for time and care, the owners of the female poodle will receive 30% of the revenue from each litter.

Funds will be disbursed upon the litter successfully reaching 9 weeks of age. Percentage owed to owners of female will not be calculated until the live litter has reached 9 weeks of age. It is important to understand that catastrophes occur and it is not uncommon to lose several puppies out of each litter in the first few weeks. These puppies will not be calculated into the total amount owed.

K. Line Poodles guarantees that we will not breed any dog beyond the age of 7 years old. Female dogs may be bred on their second heat cycle or at 18 months of age (whichever comes first) and as often as every 5 months, although K. Line Poodles may choose to skip several breedings to prioritize the health of the female. There is no guaranteed number of breedings as we cannot predict nature. If a dog is determined to be infertile or unfit to breed upon reproductive veterinary inspection, K. Line Poodles will declare this contract null and void.

Owners of the female will be responsible for ALL routine and surgical medical bills, feeding costs, grooming costs, infrastructure for safe care and keeping, and other expenses related to owning a pet unless determined otherwise by K. Line Poodles.

Owners of female MUST provide proof of all breed-standard genetic health testing through Embark, PawPrint Genetics, or other reputable DNA testing company. Dog must also have proof of thyroid testing from a certified veterinarian. If dog is determined to have a genetic disorder that is detrimental to future offspring, the dog will not be able to join the K9 Partners program. All health testing is to be paid for by owners of female.

Owners of female will be expected to feed a puppy food approved by K. Line Poodles as well as a prenatal vitamin recommended by K. Line Poodles. Owners of the female will be responsible for all prenatal costs associated with the pregnancy until custody of the dog is handed over to K. Line Poodles.

K. Line Poodles will cover certain costs associated with reproduction after the female has been bred, including ultrasounds, stud fees, costs of artificial insemination or transcervical insemination, care and keeping while in custody of K. Line Poodles, marketing of litter and treatment for mastitis.

K. Line Poodles will whelp and raise the puppies until they go to their new homes and will assume registered ownership of the litter, including all expenses associated with raising the litter of puppies.

In the event that a caesarean section is needed, owners of female will be notified immediately and K. Line Poodles will make arrangements for transportation to and from the vet clinic. K. Line Poodles will cover 50% of the costs of the procedure and the owners of the female will cover 50% of the costs of the procedure (to be paid at time of service via PayPal, Venmo or credit card).

K. Line Poodles reserves the sole right to breed the dog while this contract is valid. If unauthorized breeding or an attempt to obstruct or terminate a planned pregnancy occurs, K. Line Poodles will declare this contract null and void and no funds will be disbursed to owners of the female. In the event of a breach of contract, owners of female will also be required to reimburse K. Line Poodles for stud fees and other breeding related expenses.

K. Line Poodles may house the dog at their facility for up to two weeks until breeding is confirmed. The dog will be kept in the safe care and keeping of K. Line Poodles from day 45 of gestation period until the litter is weaned at 5 weeks of age (barring unforeseen circumstances). Owners of female are encouraged to visit their dog throughout her pregnancy and are welcome to be a part of the whelping process.

K. Line Poodles will hold the breeding rights to the female on a litter-by-litter basis. This contract must be signed and dated by both parties prior to each breeding taking place.

### **Conditions**

Owners of the female must feed a dog food approved by K. Line Poodles.

Owners of the female must take care of the dog at a level of exception, exhibiting love, safety, and a healthy environment.

It is the owners of the female's responsibility to provide all routine veterinary checkups, shots, etc. This is necessary for creating a healthy pet and breeder. K. Line Poodles may ask for vet records and other pertinent information periodically, so it is important to keep it in a safe place and treat it as though it were your own birth certificate.

Owners of the female must find a reputable and qualified veterinarian.

During and before pregnancy, owners of the female must keep dog out of harm's way to the best of their abilities. Visits to dog parks are not advised. Dog must be kept away from any animals infected with contagious diseases such as parvo, giardia, heartworm and such to the best of the foster parent's abilities. If contamination occurs, please contact K. Line Poodles immediately and measures of prevention will be taken on our part. Owners of the female are responsible for all treatments and expenses related to infections.

By signing this contract, owners of the female assume the risks associated with breeding, including but not limited to accidental death or injury. K. Line Poodles will do all in their power to keep the female safe from harm, but cannot be held responsible for any risks associated with breeding or otherwise during or after pregnancy.

Participation in AKC/UKC field trials, 4-H activities, dog shows, agility competitions, service animal certifications, etc. are highly encouraged but not mandatory.

Prior to entering K. Line Poodle's K9 Partners program, applicants must fill out a questionnaire provided by K. Line Poodles and send a minimum of 3 photos of the following sequence to K. Line Poodles: 1) left side profile. 2) right side profile. 3) front facing profile. Ensure that these photos are website-quality as we will be using them for advertising purposes.

If the above terms are met and agreed upon, an applicant will be put on a waiting list for the next available foster poodle as determined by K. Line Poodles. K. Line Poodles reserves the right to refuse any and all applicants. If above terms are not met at any point during the contract, K. Line Poodles may determine this contract null and void and no funds will be disbursed.
